## WJTA 2019 Focuses on Safety Best Practices, Equipment, New Technologies

July 26, 2019, St. Louis, MO – The 2019 WJTA Conference and Expo will be held November 11-13 in New Orleans at the Morial Convention Center. A daylong pre-conference short course will be held on Monday, November 11, and the conference sessions and expo activities will take place on Tuesday and Wednesday, November 12-13. New to the program this year is a dedicated session track for asset owners and a panel discussion on collaboration between asset owners, contractors, and original equipment manufacturers (OEMs).

Organized by the WaterJet Technology Association (WJTA), the Conference/Expo is the major academic conference, tradeshow, and educational program for high pressure waterjet technology, industrial/municipal cleaning and vacuuming and related services.

WJTA's live equipment demonstrations have been an extremely popular part of the program for over 27 years. Participants will see cutting edge equipment operating live and under pressure, showing the mechanics behind the operation and the safety practices that can help prevent jobsite incidents.

Finally, a global exposition of new industrial waterjet/waterblast tools and equipment, trucks, ancillaries and service providers will be displayed in the exhibit hall. Leading manufacturers and contractors will display a range of heavy equipment as well as interactive, hands-on tooling setups.
